Festival in Facts

- The Momasar Utsav is an annual festival of folk music and folk art. This two-day festival is organized in Momasar town of Bikaner district.
- Momasar Utsav has been conceptualized by Shri Vinod Joshi, a noted folk music expert who is also the festival's director.
- This festival is a unique amalgamation of about 200 folk artists from all the 7 cultural regions of Rajasthan. It is a platform of art that welcomes different views, and beliefs and art lovers with open arms.
- Momasar Festival will take place at Momasar, a small town in Rajasthan's Bikaner District, on October 14-15, 2022.
- During the festival, folk song concerts and endangered artforms will be performed.
- This event provides a chance to see and learn about the precious traditions of Rajasthan's beautiful land.
- Every year, around 10,000 residents from nearby villages, as well as from far-flung cities and countries, participate in this special occasion.
- The previous edition of the festival was organised on 19-20 October 2019.
- Artists from all across the state showcased folk art along with music and theatrical performances like Kathak (Jaipur Gharana), Jugalbandi,

Nirguna and Saguna Bhajans, Hungarian (Gypsy) folk music, and "Khejdi Ki Beti".

- The festival is organized in association with the residents of Momasar, Jajam Foundation, Gemini Corporation (Belgium), Suravi Charitable Trust Jaipur, Sancheti Tea Company Kolkata and Mercury Design Jaipur.
- It is truly a 'Community Festival' with the residents of the community working together to make it a success. In today's world it is very rare to see such a unique event.
